GRANT PROJECT ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Alamance County Board of Commissioners that, pursuant to Section 13.2 of Chapter 159 of the General Statutes of North Carolina, the following grant project is hereby adopted:

Section 1. The 2021 State Appropriations Act authorized funding to Alamance County to assist in the construction, renovation, and purchase of equipment projects. **Amendment 1: Budget interest earned, \$2,148.99, for the Eli Whitney Project.**

Section 2. The officers of Alamance County unit are hereby directed to proceed with the grant project within the terms of the grant document(s), the rules and regulations of these funds and the budget contained herein.

Section 3. The following revenues are anticipated to be available to complete this project:

Section 5. The finance officer is hereby directed to maintain within the Grant Project Fund sufficient specific detailed accounting records to provide the accounting to the grantor agency required by the grant agreement(s) and federal and state regulations.

Section 6. The finance officer is directed to report quarterly on the financial status of each project element in Section 4 and on the total grant revenues received or claimed.

Section 7. The budget officer is directed to include a detailed analysis of past and future costs and revenues on this grant project in every budget submission made to this board.
