CONSTRUCTION DELIVERY METHODS

DESIGN-BID-BUILD (Hard Bid)

CONSTRUCTION MANAGER AT RISK (CMAR)





PROS:

- Greatest level of competition
- Lowest initial construction cost
- Contractually least complex

PROS:

- + CM Selected on qualifications, not price
- Open book project financials
- CM on board during design for constructability reviews and cost estimating
- Maintains competitive pricing through multiple subcontractor bids
- Offers a guaranteed maximum price prior to construction commencing
- May offer better construction schedule management

CONS:

- GC qualifications are secondary to price
- GC not on-board during design
- More susceptible to Change Orders and disputes
- Lower bidder often has shortcomings in subcontractor scopes

CONS:

- Higher initial Cost than Design-Bid-Build
- Higher initial cost particularly needs to be weighted with the value gained on projects under 10 million
