WHEREAS, clerks, through their dedication to professional development, not only improve the efficacy of their offices but also bring positive recognition to their counties by participating in advanced education and obtaining profession related certifications.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT PROCLAIMED by the Alamance County Board of Commissioners that May 4 through May 10, 2025, will be recognized as "Clerks to the Board of County Commissioners Week" in Alamance County and extends its appreciation to the Clerk to the Board's Office, and to all county clerks for the vital services they perform and their exemplary dedication to the county they represent.
