#### **ISSUE/ACTION REQUESTED:**

The board will consider a request to approve opioid settlement resolution #3 to direct expenditures in the amount of \$590,134.52.

#### **BACKGROUND/PURPOSE OF REQUEST:**

At the board's March 3, 2025, meeting, Ashley Barber, Division Director for Behavioral Health/Substance Use Services, presented the FY25–26 opioid settlement funding recommendations to the board.

The recommendations included \$136,554.52 to fund salary and fringe benefits for county personnel who dedicate at least 50% of their time and one full-time position dedicating 100% of their time to planning, coordinating, implementing, and monitoring opioid settlement and remediation programs.

Additionally, \$453,580.00 was recommended to fund recovery services at the Alamance Behavioral Health Center, and peer support services for domestic violence victims with opioid use disorder, co-occurring substance use disorders, or mental health conditions.

The total recommended amount for board approval is \$590,134.52 for FY25–26. As of December 31, 2024, the total amount of available opioid settlement funds is \$2,513,748.66.

#### **RECOMMENDATION:**

Public health staff recommend adopting the resolution to direct expenditures of opioid settlement funds.
